Hermann Park Conservancy took on the renovation and improvement of the train and its track this year, showcasing the new train and extended route to an enthusiastic public in March. As a part of our strategic direction to generate additional funding for Park operations, the Conservancy was pleased to take over management of the train this year. Now, not only will Hermann Park Railroad be an enjoyable activity for Park-goers, but it will produce valuable revenue to support Park maintenance.

And soon, our train will have a worthy new home! Kinder Station will greet visitors to the new Lake Plaza, scheduled to open in March 2009. Lake Plaza will offer many new amenities to Park visitors, including a café and dining terrace, The Tiffany & Co. Foundation Bridge, boathouse and maintenance facility, public restrooms, and gift shop.

The Conservancy is especially thankful for the support of the Kinder Foundation, Houston

Endowment Inc., and The Fondren Foundation this fiscal year for helping us realize our vision for Lake Plaza.

This year we saw great enthusiasm from our community, whether at the dedication of the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. statue in December, the new Hermann Park train debut, or the sold-out inaugural Bob and Elyse Lanier Awards Luncheon in March. I look forward to seeing Lake Plaza bring people together more than ever once open next year.

I am proud to have served as board chair during this exciting revitalization of Hermann Park. Established nearly one hundred years ago, it is hard not to marvel at its enduring legacy within our great city. The Conservancy would not have been able to carry out its impressive list of improvement and maintenance projects without its dedicated base of supporters. We humbly thank you for your gifts of funding, time, and encouragement. BRINGING HOUSTON TOGETHER

This year, Hermann Park drew an estimated **six million visitors** — more than all of Houston’s sports venues combined.

Over **288,000 tickets** were sold for the Hermann Park Railroad.

The Hermann Park pedal boats made nearly **12,000 trips** around McGovern Lake.



CENTENNIAL CAMPAIGN

Hermann Park Railroad

- The new and improved Hermann Park train, with larger seats and wheelchair accessible cars, made its debut in March.
- Hermann Park Railroad's track was extended to two miles around the Park.



Japanese Garden Renovation

- Esteemed landscape architect Terunobu Nakai and landscape gardener Hiroshi Iwasaki visited Hermann Park in September 2007 and March 2008 to continue restoration efforts.
- Over 30 trainees developed skills needed to volunteer in the Japanese Garden.



Lake Plaza

- Construction began on the new Lake Plaza, paving the way for its expected opening in March 2009.

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Statue

- Community leaders came together in December 2007 to dedicate the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. statue in the Garden Center in Hermann Park.



PROGRAMS & MAINTENANCE

Volunteer and Educational Programs

- Over 90 individuals made a visible difference by contributing more than 1,500 hours to beautify Hermann Park.
- Nearly 70 corporate, family, college, and community-based groups, pulled together almost 1,600 volunteers to complete nearly 8,000 hours of service.
- Eagle Scouts took on projects within the Park, bringing together over 60 volunteers and producing over 300 volunteer hours.
- 15 middle and high school students participated in the Conservation Posse pilot program this summer. Through a variety of educational and volunteer projects, they enthusiastically completed 900 volunteer hours.
- The Conservancy launched the Job Shadowing program, designed to give young adult volunteers the chance to learn more about working in the Park and gain valuable job skills.
- Through partnerships with Alabama-Coushatta, ExxonMobil, and Shell Oil Company, the Conservancy trained six interns, who together spent more than 1,200 hours working in the office as well as the Park, saving the Conservancy nearly \$11,000.

Stewardship and Tree Care

- Over 60 trees were planted, adding to the Conservancy's inventory of nearly 6,800 trees.
- Over 80 trees were protected prior to Lake Plaza construction.
- Over 20 trees, including large pines and live oaks, were transplanted to make way for the new train maintenance facility.
- Over 5,500 hours of maintenance were facilitated through the Harris County community service program.
- Maintenance staff completed over 3,500 hours of Park beautification.

Through volunteer and maintenance programs, Hermann Park Conservancy coordinated more than 21,000 hours of service in the Park.



EVENTS

- Over 1,000 runners, wheelchair racers, walkers, and children participated in Park to Park Run, an increase of 25% over 2007.
- The Evening in the Park Gala raised over \$437,000 for Conservancy programs and operations.
- Over 250 tickets were sold to the inaugural Bob and Elyse Lanier Awards Luncheon, otherwise known as the Ladies' Hat Day Luncheon. The event was recognized by the Best Charitable Events as the Best New Event of 2008.
- Urban Green, the Conservancy's young professionals' organization, continued to inspire a new generation of supporters through two signature events, the Holiday Al Fresco and Zen Dig II.
